Footnotes

SNAP HAPPY broke a step slow, was shaken up soon after, grabbed the bit and quickly moved up along the rail nearing the half mile marker, rated close around the turn, angled out for room into the lane, advanced between rivals in upper stretch, closed sharply to collar TALE OF THE FOX near the sixteenth marker then edged clear late under steady handling. TALE OF THE FOX prompted the pace two wide under a rating hold, moved to command past the five sixteenths pole, edged away into the lane, was joined past the furlong marker and gave way grudgingly. MISS FLEETFOOT failed to keep pace early while off the rail and under a ride, angled out five wide into the stretch, drifted in past the eighth pole and lacked a solid response. BRAVE AS A LION lagged back for a half mile, raced six wide in upper stretch, had some belated interest but never threatened. PERFECT MEASURE stalked the pace three wide, was put to a ride mid turn, came four wide for the drive and weakened in the final furlong. SOUTHERN SQUALL set a pressured pace along the rail and tired in upper stretch.
