Footnotes

UNBRIDLED DANGER , between rivals early, advanced three wide into the stretch, closed under left handed pressure, shifted in nearing the sixteenth pole when COMMUNICATOR drifted out and forged clear. COMMUNICATOR dueled inside early, drew off around the the turn, entered the lane two wide, was sell clear with a furlong remaining, drifted out badly, tired and just held the place. CARSON'S HAWK , hustled along towards the inside, angled out three wide past the five sixteenths marker, advanced between foes mid stretch, angled in late, finished up willingly and just lost the bob for the place. HESA BIG STAR , taken to rate early and angled out, commenced a four to five wide run leaving the three eighths pole, steadily advanced past the eighth pole, steadied late and angled in. OUTQUEST broke a step slow, saved ground while outrun around the turn, eased out for the drive but lacked a solid run. FUNKY COUNTRY , away alertly, disputed the pace two wide, chased around the turn then tired in upper stretch. SUNDAY BLITZ , three to four wide chasing the early pace, dropped back. WILD AWAKE , wide into the turn, was outrun.
