KENS CAPE stalked the pace, eased out to the four path leaving the turn, swept to command near the eighth pole then drew clear under a hand ride. SIN AND THE CITY stalked the pace, moved up in the three path to challenge for the lead entering the stretch, continued gamely but was no match for the winner. SUN DANCE MOON lacked speed, advanced in the two path between horses mid way on the turn and closed nicely. PEACEADACTION disputed the pace two wide around the turn, remained prominent to midstretch then weakened late. WESTERN TEASE, wide around the turn, was not a threat. OUR BIG WALLY saved ground and was not a factor. EXXEL, in the three path between horses on the turn, was not a factor. UNO CALIENTE saved ground disputing the pace, drifted out in upper stretch and faltered.
