TOMMIE'S STAR circled the turn, sprinted clear in upper stretch, drifted in near the eighth pole and lasted under urging. EXCITING TIMES saved ground, eased out in upper stretch and finished willingly. JOEL'S TOUCH circled the turn, was four wide in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. FIFTY SEVEN G sped to the front, set the pace near the rail and gave way. ALLEN'S KAT saved ground while outrun. BABALO raced well off the rail and was outrun.
