Footnotes

WICKED THUNDER , forwardly placed, moved up behind rivals mid turn, angled in and got through along the rail in upper stretch, forged to command a furlong out, kicked clear near the sixteenth pole, drifted out some late and prevailed under a solid drive. BROAD RULE broke a step slow, quickly recovered and moved wide to contention into the turn, patiently rated three wide mid turn, shifted out five wide in upper stretch, closed gamely through the final sixteenth and missed. GATORS CHOICE prompted the pace two to three wide, gained command entering the stretch, was joined from the inside by the winner nearing the eighth pole then weakened late while drifted out. GAELIC PARTNER sprinted three wide to a clear early lead, dropped in some to set the pace, took pressure mid turn, drifted out some nearing the lane and weakened in the final furlong. JINJALAD flashed speed along the rail, was put to a ride early turn and failed to respond. ALWAYS EARLY , taken to rate early, angled out wide for the run around the turn but failed to rally. COTURNIX had brief foot in the two path then dropped back around the turn.
