BOLTING GEORGETT, hustled along early, set the pace along the rail, drifted out in the drive and gamely prevailed. SECRET'S LAST SAY prompted the pace outside the winner in a sharp effort. LUSTY GIRL lacked room from the quarter pole to the three sixteenths pole, angled outside in mid stretch and closed rapidly. BRONZE PLUMAGE raced inside horses and flattened out. HEADING SOUTH, outrun to the stretch, passed tired ones. QUEEN'S PRIDE, wide on the turn, weakened. BOGUS BABE, five wide on the turn, weakened. NECTARIA, three wide between horses, weakened. KALMIA ROAD faltered along the rail.
