Footnotes

WILD LOUIS settle into stride three wide, angled out a bit wider past the five sixteenths marker, rolled up to confront PLAY EIGHTEEN approaching the stretch, quickly spurred clear nearing the eighth pole and held firm under solid left handed encouragement. ROCKY GAP lacked speed while off the rail, commenced a run mid turn while under strong urging, swung five wide continuing his advance into the stretch, gave willing chase and held down the place. FLYING POSSE, between rivals early, edged closer after a half mile, chased between horses in mid stretch then hung late racing to the inside of ROCKY GAP. LEMON JUICE was rated back well off the early, pace, swung out six wide into the lane and had some belated action. IN HOT PURSUIT saved ground, eased out gaining some ground in upper stretch but failed to sustain through the final furlong. LAST LAUGH NOW chased the pace, gained along the rail near the quarter pole then tired in the final furlong. PLAY EIGHTEEN broke a step slow, was hard used inside and went clear, began getting out early turn, was collared after a half mile then faltered.
