Footnotes

ST JOHN'S GOSPEL stalked the pace three wide, edged closer after a half mile, moved to even terms nearing the eighth pole, dueled briefly then steadily widened under a drive. ROMAN'S TOUCH moved clear early under rating, set the pace two wide into the lane, responded when set down in upper stretch to widen slightly, battled inside the winner past the eighth pole then gave way grudgingly. SANDBAGIN' LOVER saved ground, shifted out near the sixteenth pole, finished willingly to the inside of CLASSIC SPEED and edged that one for the show. CLASSIC SPEED rated off the rail, angled outward in the final sixteenth and kept on with interest. BEACON HALL , forwardly placed towards the inside, eased out mid turn, challenged between runners nearing the quarter pole, chased the top pair to the furlong grounds then weakened. TRUE TO TRADITION saved ground off the pace and under some urging, swung five wide into the lane and faded. PHIL'S TANGO , urged along trying to keep pace, angled six wide past the quarter pole and tired.
