POLISH CHOICE saved ground stalking the pace, eased out two wide entering the stretch, led in midstretch and dug in tenaciously. REEFME DARLING saved ground entering the stretch, eased out in upper stretch and rallied. PRESS DOLL set a pressured pace along the rail and faded. RICO ENDS WELL , three wide the first turn, raced five wide entering the stretch and was no threat. THE FIFTH ELEMENT , three wide entering the stretch, lacked a rally. HOSTA LA BYE BYE dueled two wide and gave way. ONE TWIST , six wide turning for home, faded. OUT WITH IT , wide leaving the far turn, gave way. PURSE SNATCHER raced along the rail while outrun. LA GRANDE BALLADE (GB) stopped. .
