CRAFTY GUY duled towards the inside into the turn, shook clear on the turn, set brisk fractions under rating, spurted away when roused in upper stretch then maintained a comfortable margin under a drive. GATORS N BEARS advanced wide to a brief lead nearing the half mile marker, chased the winner while three wide on the turn, finished well but was no match. GIMMEAWINK broke sluggishly, trailed into the turn, advanced some four wide nearing the quarter pole, angled wider for the drive and finished with interest. RUN PRODUCTION lacked speed, was hustled along three wide on the turn, drifted in a bit in mid stretch and failed to mount a serious response. MT. CARSON rated close up while three wide, moved closer four wide into the lane, chased then weakened in mid stretch. ALI'S PRIDE failed to keep pace. MOSES JEROME lost ground four to five wide and dropped back on the turn. OUR MARCH HARE chased the pace while saving ground and tired before going a half mile.
