FIT TO KILL set the pace along the rail and lasted under urging. VALLEY PARKING , three wide both turns, had dead aim on the winner in upper stretch then flattened out. FRIEL'S FOR REAL raced along the rail entering the backstretch, dropped back midway on the backstretch, swung to the five path in upper stretch and rallied too late. NAULT , swung wide in upper stretch, lacked the needed late effort. KYRENIA , three wide the far turn, drifted to the six path in midstretch and was no threat. SHOP TILL YOU DROP , a forward factor two wide, gave way. DECK GAME raced well off the rail and gave way. VEGAS ALARM , four wide both turns, faltered.
