MAGIC EIGHT BALL , patiently handled while saving some ground and tracking the pace, angled three wide and set his sights on the leader entering the lane, responded when roused left handed approaching the furlong, drew alongside in mid stretch, dueled, poked a head in front a sixteenth out and dug in to gamely to prevail. VIDEO STORM quickly went clear and angled to about the two path to set a rated pace, was called upon in upper stretch, met the challenge of the winner in mid stretch, battled gamely and missed in a sharp effort. LOEWENHERZ , five wide outside rivals early, dropped in to about the three path and quickly moved to contention into the turn, chased the winner four wide into the stretch and stayed on well. BLACK FOREST , between runners early, raced within range into the stretch, shifted towards the rail in mid stretch and kept on willingly. RUNNIN FROM LOVE broke a step slow, was taken five wide soon after, made a slight move past the three eighths pole, chased and went evenly late. DR. DREW , three wide between foes nearing the turn, angled five wide approaching the quarter pole and came up empty. VOLASTIC was rated back from between runners after a furlong and failed to respond.
