Footnotes

KOBOLD quickly went clear, set the pace along the inside, turned back ELUSIVE RUNAWAY in midstretch and drew away under a drive. ELUSIVE RUNAWAY was allowed to settle, steadily advanced three wide into the far turn, moved closer in midstretch, flattened out and was clearly second best. AMAZING TRUTH rated close up between rivals near the five furlong marker, raced five wide in upper stretch and continued willingly. NIGHTIME DANCES prompted the pace two wide and faded. AMOURETTE saved ground in a forward position, was put to urging near the three furlong marker and tired.
