LET ME BE FRANK , sent to the front, set the pace near the rail, was challenged in midstretch, repulsed that bid and prevailed under steady handling. DOC MAGOVERN stalked the pace, circled the far turn, challenged for the lead in midstretch but hung. QUANTICO HERO broke alertly, was checked along the rail entering the first turn, was steadied entering the backstretch, saved ground, eased out in upper stretch then came up empty. SINGIN THE BLUES lacked speed, saved ground most of the trip and rallied mildly. NINIAN lacked speed, circled the far turn and was not a factor. MY CRUSADER , wide both turns, drifted in near the eighth pole and was outrun. FINGER TAPPING , four wide the first turn, raced in the three path on the far turn and gave way. DARBYS DISPUTE stumbled leaving the starting gate, prompted the pace outside the winner to the far turn then faltered.
