Footnotes

CHANGING FUNDS lacked speed, raced wide entering the stretch, took command in midstretch and drew away under energetic urging. GRUNWALD , four wide the first turn, moved up three wide to gain the lead mid way on the far turn, led to midstretch then tired. BAGOGA lacked speed, worked between horses in upper stretch, swung to the far outside inside the eighth pole and passed tired horses. DOMESTIC AFFAIR , three wide the far turn, gave way in midstretch. SUMMER OF SUMMERS sped to the front, set the pace along the rail and faded in the stretch. ENSIGN THREE STIX , well off the rail in the stretch, failed to rally. BLUE ORGIN stalked the pace, moved up in the two path between horses on the far turn and gave way in midstretch. WATCH ROCK , outrun, saved ground the far turn. SUE'S DIAMOND , wide entering the stretch, gave way. KINGSDALE OCEAN (IRE) , outrun, dropped back.
