Footnotes

GULLY , settled nicely down the backstretch while towards the inside, moved closer under rating leaving the far turn, awaited room mid way on the final turn, got through along the rail to challenge into the lane, dueled inside QUARTERS past the furlong marker then edged clear late under solid left handed pressure. QUARTERS cleared early and angled towards the inside, set the pace under snug rating, turned back an initial challenge entering the far turn, edged back clear after six furlongs, drifted off the rail nearing the lane allowing the winner room, dueled outside that one past the eighth pole, gave way grudgingly and saved the place. ENIGMATIC settled off the rail, advanced three wide into the far turn to be within striking distance, had dead aim four wide into the stretch but could not muster a solid response. BID TIL INCLUDED , unhurried early while saving ground, picked up some momentum leaving the far turn, swung out five wide entering the stretch and rallied belatedly. FAST TALKING stalked the pace off the rail, made a mild bid to challenge into the far turn, chased between rivals mid way on the final turn then faltered.
