ELISE'S NOTEBOOK , unhurried early, brushed with OUT WITH IT when taken five wide in upper stretch, closed and narrowly prevailed. SEATTLE SOCIALITE stalked the pace, advanced along the rail to bid for the lead in midstretch and continued gamely. PERSONAL FLAIR raced seven wide in the stretch and rallied. ROCKIN ROY , two wide the first turn, raced along the rail on the far turn, dueled and faded. CRAFTY DIPLOMAT raced in the three path in the stretch and passed tired ones. OUT WITH IT circled the far turn, raced six wide in upper stretch and weakened. FIGHTING DUCHESS , three wide both turns, chased the pace and gave way. QUOIT QUICK , used three wide leaving the first turn, disputed the pace and gave way in upper stretch. KRISACIA was outrun.
