BALTIMORE BELLE , under snug rating towards the inside while just off a contested pace, swung out five wide entering the lane, rallied to collar LOVE'S BLUSH a furlong out, dueled the sixteenth marker then edged away late under a drive. LOVE'S BLUSH prompted the pace three to four wide under rating, rallied to command in upper stretch, dueled inside the winner from the furlong pole to the sixteenth marker then gave way grudgingly. ACCESS TO CHARLIE gained command leaving the chute, set a pressured pace towards the inside, was headed a quarter mile out, chased the leaders past the eighth pole and continued on willingly. FOOLS IN LOVE settled back off the pace while removed from the inside, made steady progress four wide approaching the stretch then went evenly through the final furlong. LILY QUATORZE disputed the pace two to three wide under firm rating, dueled past the half mile marker, continued a forward presence into the stretch then gave way. ART OF THE HUNT saved ground without a response. ALPHA DARLIN , between rivals nearing the turn, retreated.
