RED HOT STAR stalked the pace three wide, was pushed along on the turn, rallied four wide to command near the sixteenth pole, drifted out a bit and held sway under a drive. STORMIN' DOWN was taken to rate four wide, advanced five wide into the stretch, rallied leaving mid stretch, angled in late but was no match. MARY AND JOAN quickly went clear, set the pace two wide into the lane, remained clear past the furlong marker then weakened very late. SULTRY PROSPECT lacked speed, raced four wide in the drive and finished willingly. IMABLAZINBEAUTY stalked the pace two to three wide and weakened. NO BIAS drifted in at the break, saved ground and faded. AUGUSTNESS broke slowly and failed to menace.
