COLES CHOICE was taken to rate, moved up between rivals nearing the far turn, advanced three wide approaching the quarter pole, took over in upper stretch and drew clear under a drive. TRUSTEES GRAY quickly went clear, set the pace along the inside to the head of the lane but was no match for the winner. CODE WOO stalked the pace off the rail, was put to pressure on the final turn and faded. DESERTS MIRACLE was outrun. POHATAN PRINCESS raced three wide down the backstretch, was put to urging near the half mile marker and tired. NORTHERN GAMBLER never threatened. SANDYE'S HALO was always far back. RUSSIAN MARKET saved ground and faltered.
