ORIENTA quickly went clear, dictated the pace under rating in the two path, widened through the lane and won with plenty in reserve. CRAFTY GETAWAY was taken to rate off the rail, angled four wide for the drive and closed willingly to get the place in the final yards. SCARLET TANGO stalked the pace three wide under some rating, made a run into the lane then flattened out through the final furlong. SCOOTIN' GIRL stumbled at the break, moved up between horses to reach contention, angled to the rail on the turn, raced close up to the head of the lane then faded. S W MAD MONEY chased the issue three wide and faded. JANA saved ground early, swung wide in upper stretch and failed to respond.
