Footnotes

SIMPLE AFFAIR settled along the inside, advanced into the far turn, lodged a rail bid three furlongs out, took a short lead nearing the lane, came out briefly in upper stretch, edged away when straightened and was kept to her business. PATRIOTS IMAGE , bumped and in tight at the break, settled off the rail, advanced towards the inside leaving the three furlong pole, angled out, lodged a three wide bid nearing the lane, finished willingly but was no match. ROSES N BOWS set the pace two wide, allowed the winner through near the three furlong marker, dueled approaching the stretch then weakened through the final eighth. POUR IT ON lost ground four to five wide throughout and continued willingly to the wire. SAINT D'OR bore out at the break bothering PATRIOTS IMAGE, saved ground early and failed to threaten. SEDUCTIVE LADY , three wide the first turn, stalked the pace four wide down the backstretch, remained a presence to the head of the lane then weakened. BAGITDON'TCHARGEIT , between rivals the first turn, prompted the pace three wide, lodged a bid near the half mile marker, weakened and was steadied near the quarter pole.
