THOMAS GOT EVEN , content to settle back off the early pace, was put to a drive while between rivals the far turn, rallied four wide into the stretch, collared WIKI in mid stretch, lugged in on a slim advantage the final sixteenth and held sway. WIKI tracked three wide under rating, moved to challenge after a half mile, dueled leaving the far turn, took over after six furlongs, opened up when roused into the lane, met the challenge of the winner a furlong out, dueled, was brushed and forced in some late and continued on gamely to just miss. TERMSOFENGAGEMENT , unhurried early while removed from the inside, circled five wide into the stretch then rallied mildly while lugging in late. EDDIE C. rated forwardly in about the two path, was nudged along to keep within range leaving the far turn, chased between rivals into the stretch but lacked a solid response. SHORDAWATYADRINK , four wide advancing to command after a quarter mile, angled in when clearing with five eighths remaining, dueled inside WIKI past the three eighths pole, was under strong urging to keep pace past the five sixteenths marker then faded in the drive. ZARROC saved ground early while under rating, eased out down the backstretch, raced between rivals around the final turn, steadied and altered in near mid stretch but failed to threaten. PARIS VEGAS , four wide early, moved menacingly three wide leaving the far turn, challenged after six furlongs, chased into the stretch then faltered leaving the three sixteenths marker. EARLY STAR saved ground in a forward position to the far turn then gave way.
