Footnotes

BANNER BOY taken in hand early and tracked a contested pace while three wide, was given his cue mid turn, advanced four wide between rivals into the stretch, forged clear in mid stretch then held firm under solid left handed encouragement. STAR MANEUVER , patiently handled while saving ground, edged up nearing the quarter pole, angled out into the lane, shifted out a bit wider as a seam closed up near the three sixteenths pole, worked his way between runners and chased the winner home in game fashion. WHERE'S DOMINIC broke a step slow, was taken to rate in last, angled out leaving the three eighths pole, gathered momentum soon after, moved menacingly six wide in upper stretch but could not match strides in the final furlong. INDEFINABLE HUMOR was sent up inside WIN WIRE soon after the break, gained slim lead around the far turn, took pressure around the turn, drifted off the inside into the lane and gave way grudgingly. DOS ORO chased off the rail, raced five wide between rivals into the stretch, shifted in a bit and kept on with interest. WIN WIRE disputed the pace two to three wide outside INDEFINABLE HUMOR then tired in upper stretch.
