Footnotes

COOL UNDER FIRE advanced well wide leaving the backstretch, drifted to the six path entering the stretch, regained the lead in midstretch and edged clear. PAGE MCKENNEY showed speed in the three path, gained the lead in upper stretch and finished gamely. COUNT TO SEVEN, angled to the five path in upper stretch, rallied between horses. FIGHTERTOWN saved ground, angled to the three path in midstretch and offered a mild rally between horses. ALWAYS SMILING hugged the rail, prompted the pace and weakened. RESPECTFUL ED circled the turn four deep, floated to the seven path in upper stretch and was not a factor. PERFECT CROSS saved ground stalking the pace and weakened. TUBAL, a forward factor two wide, gave way in upper stretch. DENVER DUEL was outrun.
