LOST JUDGEMENT disputed the pace two wide, drew clear around the final turn and maintained a safe margin under a drive. MIDNITE MADNESS stalked the pace and gained little in the final furlong. BEAUTIFUL FEELING was allowed to settle towards the inside, moved up between rivals near the three furlong marker and rallied mildly. GREY SKY broke slowly, saved ground around the final turn, angled out and failed to menace. LITTLE BIG THORN saved ground and came up empty. MISS BROAD had her rider's saddle slip in the early stages, disputed the pace along the inside for five furlongs then surrendered. GINGERY made a mild four wide run into the far turn then weakened. IT'S APPROVED dropped back after a half mile. LA SAMANNA faltered and was being eased.
