Footnotes

I CAN DO IT raced wide on the turn, took command entering the stretch, drew off under urging and drifted in near the sixteenth pole. OUR FOOLISH PARKER bid for the lead three wide on the turn and weakened the final furlong. ELLOREE WARRIOR lacked speed, swung very wide in upper stretch and rallied mildly. CARTER'S SONG, a forward factor along the rail, was shuffled back on the turn, swung wide in the stretch and passed tired ones. EXTREME MONSTER gave way. NO CROSSING LANE chased the pace two wide and gave way. PATAPSCO COMMANDER was outrun. CLUB TANGO raced very wide. GREAT PEACE was outrun. FOR CHARLIE G showed speed along the rail and stopped.
