SILVER MARKET was sent clear early and angled in, was nicely rated, turned away PRINCESS MEDORA entering the lane, opened up when put to a stiff drive in upper stretch, drifted out some near the eighth pole, was straightened away and continued to widen under aggressive handling. PRINCESS MEDORA broke a step slow, was angled out some and moved up three wide into the turn, made a quick advance past the three eighths pole to take aim on the winner, was refuted in upper stretch but continued willingly to save the place. REALLY BULLISH saved ground while forward early, was shuffled back when in close entering the turn, regrouped to make progress along the rail approaching the lane, angled out and came up empty. GIAELLE lost ground four wide to mid turn, shifted to the rail in the drive and had belated interest. TRIPPI'S WISH, ridden along two wide giving chase, tired.
