Footnotes

RIDETHESILVERTRAIN hugged the rail on the turn, swung to the four path in upper stretch, bid for the lead between horses, dueled inside CALL OF A LION the final three sixteenths of a mile and got the bob at the wire. CALL OF A LION , forwardly placed in the two path on the turn, was floated to the five path by RIDETHESILVERTAIN in upper stretch, dueled outside that one and just missed in another game performance. REGAL NURSE saved ground disputing the pace, drifted to the two path in upper stretch and weakened the final furlong. WIN PICTURE dueled outside REGAL NURSE and weakened the final eighth of a mile. GLORIOUS NOTION saved ground and failed to menace. ELECTRIC VENUS , outrun, floated to the six path in upper stretch. LOOKIN' FOXY , three wide on the turn, was outrun. BROAD OUTLINE , three wide on the turn, stalked the pace to the stretch then faltered.
