GOOD TIME HENNY , lightly bumped by BUY BUY MISTAKE leaving the starting gate, hugged the inner rail, advanced on the turn, eased out to the three path leaving the bend, swept to command in upper stretch then eagerly pulled away while kept to his business. BRET'S AT CADDIES stalked the pace, was three deep leaving the turn, failed to be a threat to the winner and gained the place. ROJO PERFECTO , lightly steadied when shuffled back near the five eighths pole, was immediately steered to the inner rail, advanced inside foes on the turn, eased out to the two path in upper stretch then flattened out. LIMESTONE COWBOY , two deep on the turn, drifted out a bit in upper stretch and failed to rally. GO GO GUS , two wide on the turn, was outrun. BUY BUY MISTAKE showed speed along the rail, came out to the two path mid way on the turn, drifted wide leaving the bend and faltered. SHOULDABEENCHARLIE , sent two wide leaving the backstretch, angled to the rail when clear near the three eighths pole, continued along the rail and faltered in upper stretch. YOUR WIFE CALLED was outrun.
