DEPUTY DANNEY quickly went clear, set a rated pace along the inside, eagerly moved away around the turn, responded to solid hand urging in upper stretch to increase his margin then was geared down a bit in the final yards. STORM DOOR brushed with FLYING PUNCH near the five eighths pole, recovered and settled off the rail, angled out five wide when advancing into the stretch and continued on with interest to be clear for the place. HEAVENSTMURGATROID , outrun for a half mile, raced three to four wide in upper stretch and had a belated response. CRAY CRAY , three wide chasing the pace, failed to respond. COOL JOE BROWN chased the winner, raced two wide into the stretch and weakened leaving the furlong pole. FLYING PUNCH , brushed and steadied when in close near the five eighths pole, saved ground leaving the three eighths pole and failed to rally. TIPSY SAINT broke outward, lost ground four wide, failed to keep pace and faded.
