Footnotes

QUARTERS , angled in leaving the backstretch, worked between horses on the turn, swung wide entering the stretch, closed determinedly and drove clear. JOEY FRIES , a forward factor early, circled the turn four wide, sprinted clear in upper stretch and gave way grudgingly. FRENCH MOON , inside horses on the turn, floated wide entering the stretch and rallied. ROCK N' BID saved ground on the turn, eased out to the two path entering the stretch, advanced to midstretch then failed to sustain his bid. COOL PUNCH saved ground, disputed the pace and weakened. GOLDEN GHOST , wide on the turn, drifted extremely wide entering the stretch then passed tired foes. SHOE FREAK MARLENE , very wide leaving the turn, was not a factor. TROJAN WAR chased the pace three wide on the turn and gave way in upper stretch. HALLUCINOJENIC , very wide entering the stretch, was outrun. BASHA'S MOON was outrun. VALUE YOUR ANGEL prompted the pace outside COOL PUNCH and faltered entering the stretch. ADIOS AMIGO , extremely wide turning for home, was outrun.
