Footnotes

KAY ONE set a slow pressured pace along the rail, briefly shook clear in upper stretch, was joined by COUNT TO SEVEN inside the eighth pole, dug in tenaciously under strong handling and prevailed. COUNT TO SEVEN stalked off the rail, ranged up three wide past the five sixteenths pole, drew alongside the winner past the sixteenth marker, dueled but just could not get past. TOP PARTNER , in close at the break, was under a ride removed from the rail mid way down the backstretch, gained four wide nearing the quarter pole, could not go with the top pair from there but did win the show battle. BACKDOOR STRIKE saved ground stalking the pace, had aim into the lane, eased out but lacked the needed finish. JOHN FRANCIS , unruly behind the gate, pressed the pace two wide to the quarter pole then faltered. MORE MOETION balked at the gate, lacked speed under urging off the rail and failed to respond.
