QUEENAMEINA , unhurried early while saving some ground, angled out near the half mile marker, circled six wide making a run into the lane, forged clear under right handed pressure leaving the three sixteenths marker and widened under constant encouragement. ANN MILLER stumbled at the break, settled off the rail, advanced four wide inside the winner leaving the three eighths pole, could continue on with that one but kept on willingly to earn the place. BETRAYED stalked the pace three to four wide, moved to challenge around the far turn, dueled into the lane then gave way grudgingly. STAR MONEY disputed the pace inside, took over mid turn, drifted out briefly while dueling into the stretch, was quickly righted but weakened in the final furlong. G'S BACKINACTION chased the pace while saving ground and weakened. VOEUX set a pressured pace between rivals and tired after five and a half furlongs. SOULFUL stumbled badly at the break, moved up between rivals nearing the three quarter pole, chased to the far turn and retreated.
