**Footnotes**

ROUND ABOUT , three wide between rivals early, steadily advanced around the turn, collared RUN A BUCK leaving the three sixteenths pole and edged away late under solid handling. RUN A BUCK sprinted clear early, set the pace along the rail, was confronted by the winner in upper stretch, battled inside that one to the sixteenth marker then gave way grudgingly. TOUGH TALKIN LADY , taken to rate early, made a solid run between rivals nearing the three furlong marker, angled out and continued a four wide run into the stretch then flattened out in the final furlong. URBAN JUNGLE lacked speed, came four wide for the drive and closed belatedly. TUXEDO PARK , unhurried early while well off the rail, came five wide under a ride into the lane but failed to threaten. AVERIL'S RING chased the pace in the two path, was brushed by WOODLAND FLUTE in upper stretch then came up empty. WOODLAND FLUTE , taken to rate, saved ground while making a mild run mid turn, brushed AVERIL'S RING when angling out in upper stretch then faded. ARCHIVE stalked the pace two wide, lodged a mild bid nearing mid turn, chased the leader into the stretch then tired three sixteenths out. ROSCOMMON COUNTY , wide, faltered after a half mile.
