PLUM was rated back after an alert start, picked up the pace under urging mid turn, eased out four wide nearing the stretch, closed steadily under left handed pressure, brushed with JAZZY IDEA in mid stretch, sustained her run and nipped MORE THAN A CRUISE in the final jumps. MORE THAN A CRUISE stalked under rating while removed from the inside, edged closer after a half mile, moved to challenge nearing the lane, dueled in upper stretch, forged to command a furlong out, finished gamely but just failed to hold off the winner. BLUEGRASS ATATUDE sprinted clear early, set the pace inside, was collared near the quarter pole, dueled mid stretch then weakened very late. JAZZY IDEA broke a step slow, steadily advanced to gain a stalking position along the rail after a half mile, took aim mid turn, shifted out for the drive, brushed with the winner in mid stretch then came up empty. TWO HEARTS IN ONE settled back while saving ground, swung out wide for the drive and closed belatedly. WILL N' PAT failed to menace. LADY GREELEY, four wide chasing the early pace, faltered.
