### Footnotes

KING AND CRUSADER pulled his way to the lead soon after the start, set a rated pace towards the inside, took pressure from the half mile marker, dueled inside GLIB from the five sixteenths marker, was headed approaching the eighth pole, battled back under left handed pressure and forged ahead late while drifting out some. GLIB prompted the pace three wide early, moved to engage the winner after a half mile, dueled, gained a short lead nearing the furlong marker then hung while floated out late. JACK'S IN THE DECK stalked the pace under rating, edged closer between rivals after a half mile, was in a bit close between foes three furlongs out, shifted out four wide entering the lane but could only muster a mild late run. ALONGCAMETHEDEVIL broke a step slow, rated between horses early, angled in and steadily gained through the final three sixteenths. SENOR QUICKIE lacked speed, saved ground into the stretch, shifted out late and had some belated interest. BULL H stumbled at the break, quickly recovered and reached contention, stalked while saving ground, angled three wide entering the stretch then tired in the final furlong. WON THE WAR stalked the pace three to four wide and weakened. MCNAIR AND ADGER, well wide throughout, failed to respond. GOING TO MARKET was outrun.
