Footnotes

PLEASANT NOTE lacked speed, raced in the four path in the stretch, split horses inside the eighth pole and drew out. AHIMSA raced wide, bid for the lead in midstretch and lacked the needed late effort. POPULAR BLUES disputed the pace racing along the rail and faded. LACY LADY dueled three wide and gave way. MUTTFACE ALISON raced along the rail and was no threat. CRACK THE BOOKS stumbled leaving the starting gate, swung very wide entering the stretch and failed to rally. CASE LOAD , six wide, was steadied when carried out a bit inside the eighth pole. MISS BERAVEN stalked the pace, raced three wide into the stretch and gave way. FILLYPASSER was outrun. INTERLUDE dueled two wide between horses and faltered.
