Footnotes

SUNUP was taken to rate early towards the inside, advanced between rivals mid way on the final turn, angled out for room in upper stretch, closed determinedly under left handed pressure and wore down BRIGHT GOLD in the final fifty yards. BRIGHT GOLD moved clear early, raced under stout restraint along the inside, turned back challenges around the final turn, went clear again nearing mid stretch, continued well but could not withstand the winner. AWESOME TOUCH prompted the pace three wide, moved closer around the final turn, finished willingly but was outfinished by the top pair. MADAM HERTFIELD was angled to the rail right after the start, settled down the backstretch, advanced along the inside leaving the three furlong marker, continued willingly but lacked some room in the final sixteenth. BREEZY BRAY raced off the rail down the backstretch, dropped back around the final turn then failed to recover. BETTY LEE , bumped at the break, was rated back off of BRIGHT GOLD around the first turn, angled to the two path, stalked the pace, lodged a bid between rivals around the far turn, forced the issue to the head of the lane then weakened. FLIRTING , bumped at the break, raced wide and weakened.
