SHOE FREAK MARLENE sped to the front, set the pace along the rail and pulled away under pressure. SHAMELESS RISK prompted the pace outside the winner and weakened. BEARZAVA , bumped and forced in leaving the starting gate, saved ground and rallied mildly. KNIGHT IN ARMOUR lacked speed, raced very wide entering the stretch and was not a factor. SEEKING REVENGE lacked speed, was steadied on the heels of a rival near the quarter pole and finished willingly between horses. CAKE bore in leaving the starting gate, raced three wide on the turn and faltered. COACH DOUG , bumped and forced in leaving the starting gate, raced along the rail and gave way. DANCIN' DIXIE CAT circled the turn and gave way.
