DEELITEFULPROSPECT cleared early from the outside and then angled in, dictated the pace, responded when put to left handed urging in the lane and widened. PRINCE OF TRICKS , taken to rate, raced between rivals nearing the half mile marker, angled out four into the stretch and finished willingly to gain the place in the final fifty yards. MOUNT WILTON , well placed inside, made a mild run in upper stretch then was outfinished for the place. KLEBER lagged while saving ground, eased out in the drive and had some belated interest. HANDSOME BRUNO , three wide chasing the pace, was urged along mid turn and steadily gave way in the drive. GAMMY'S A WINNER had no excuse stalking the winner and gave way nearing mid stretch. BOUND TO BE SMART lost ground and failed to respond. MAJOR MALIBU , saved ground early, faltered nearing the turn and was eased in upper stretch.
