ASK THE MOON prompted the pace three wide under a light hold, moved closer into the lane, took over approaching the three sixteenths pole and steadily widened under a drive. HARTIGAN settled inside, commenced a run mid turn, swung out five wide entering the lane, finished well and was clearly second best. KOSMO'S BUDDY sprinted clear inside early, set a moderate pace, took pressure into the lane, was headed in upper stretch and weakened late. SNOW PARK, outrun early, raced five to six wide in upper stretch and had some belated interest. GUARDIAN SPIRIT bore out at the break, lacked speed, raced inside in the drive and failed to menace. BRASS BRAE stalked the pace two wide, was urged along mid turn then weakened in upper stretch. AFRICAN TREASURE saved ground, raced forwardly for nearly six furlongs then steadily retreated. OUR BONNIE BRAE, wide, stalked the pace for a little more than a half mile then faltered.
