MENIFEE SIX, patiently handled, moved up in the three path leaving the turn, took the lead outside foes in midstretch then drew out under urging. EVENING CONCERTO circled the turn in the three path and rallied outside horses. VALENTINO'S BOY chased the pace outside CALL THE NATIVES, overtook that one entering the stretch and weakened late. TOOTS raced in the two path on the turn, failed to be a factor and passed tired horses. SELF DEALIN' MAN saved ground and was not a factor. CALL THE NATIVES showed speed along the rail and faltered in upper stretch. R. B. FLOAT trailed.
