SEARCH FOR A CURE was well placed off of a disputed pace, came wide for the drive, closed steadily under stout right handed pressure and got up in the final yards. DARNESTOWN , three wide early, lodged a bid into the turn, dueled from the three furlong marker to deep stretch and finished gamely. BAMBAs set the early pace along the inside, dueled inside of DARNESTOWN from the three eighths pole to late, finished gamely and just missed the place. PHYXIUS lacked speed, raced very wide in the drive and rallied mildly. LEXILOUSH , sluggish early, moved up five wide into the turn, closed some ground but failed to really threaten. THE FIFTH ELEMENT , wide, was not a factor. WONDEROUS WOMAN saved ground early, raced between rivals in mid stretch but failed to make an impact. RAZOR STUBBLE pressed the early pace two wide and dropped back entering the lane. HOT EXPECTATIONS , bumped at the break, steadied back when in tight near the four and a half furlong marker and failed to menace. OH SABLE failed to menace and raced wide in the drive. RICO ENDS WELL , bumped at the break, dropped back on the turn, ducked in and hit the rail in mid stretch and was pulled up.
