LEGIT PASSION , sent to the front, set the pace, raced in the two path through the stretch and lasted after drifting in and bumping CASEY'S MUSIC near the sixteenth pole. CASEY'S MUSIC , unhurried early, advanced along the rail through the stretch, challenged for the lead inside the eighth pole and hung after being bumped in the drive. KIYOSHI lost ground around the turns, raced wide entering the stretch and flattened out. ROOTEEN HERO lacked speed, swung to the six path in upper stretch and rallied mildly. DUDE AGAIN stalked the pace, angled to the rail inside the eighth pole and failed to rally. BEAN prompted the pace outside LEGIT PASSION and gave way. JETS NICE AN NASTY , outrun, raced along the rail. CRUISINWITHCHARLIE , wide the far turn, gave way. Following an objection by the rider of CASEY'S MUSIC, LEGIT PASSION was disqualified and placed second.
