TYLER'S SMILE bumped CALPYSO BOB when bearing out leaving the starting gate, rushed up along the rail to take command in upper stretch then eagerly pulled away while kept under constant urging. KATMAI UNLEASHED chased the pace between horses, was in the three path leaving the turn and gave way in upper stretch. SEATTLE SALUTE, bumped and forced out by CALYPSO BOB soon after the break, raced off the rail, bore out in upper stretch then passed tired horses. SKILLET GLACIER, checked when pinched back by SEATTLE SALUTE soon after the break, circled the turn, was carried to the six path by SEATTLE SALUTE in upper stretch, angled in near the eighth pole then finished willingly. BREEZY LOUIE circled the turn, chased the pace, entered the stretch in the four path then faltered. CALYPSO BOB, bumped and forced out by TYLER'S SMILE leaving the starting gate, set the pace inside horses, turned for home in the two path and faltered. HARRY THE TANK was outrun. SUCCINCT broke down on the turn.
