SEATTLE PROSPECT, under snug rating well off the rail and within range, edged closer mid turn, responded to stout right handed pressure and kicked clear inside the three sixteenths pole, widened under constant right handed encouragement then was taken in hand the final fifty yards. KIPPERS N' EGGS prompted the pace two wide, bid to lead after a half mile, went clear mid turn, was overtaken inside the three sixteenths marker then gave willing chase while saving the place. PHIL'S TANGO saved ground off the pace, swung four to five wide making a run into the lane but lacked the needed finish. COUNT ON LOU stalked the pace three wide, gained some around the turn, gave chase through the lane but came up empty in the final furlong. BLACK TIE ONLY, unhurried early, circled four to five wide into the stretch but lacked a rally. COBALT CAT stalked the pace two wide and tired. HINT was outrun. LATER GATER never menaced. TRIPPLITE was sent up inside and popped a head in front, dueled inside KIPPERS N' EGGS into the turn, lost the lead after a half mile, chased then faltered entering the stretch.
