COBBLER'S MARK saved ground, disputed the pace, assumed a clear lead entering the stretch and was under brisk urging in the drive. BRAWL , two wide, stalked the pace and rallied late. SOME WAY SOME HOW , three wide on the turn, stalked the pace and closed the gap late. JUDGE WYLIE disputed the pace three wide, bore out leaving the turn then finished willingly. FOREVER GALLANT , four wide turning for home, was not a threat. IT'S A BLUFF saved ground and was not a factor. GIACOVANI was outrun.
