Footnotes

BOCCE BOY saved ground on the turn, eased out leaving the bend, swung to the four path in upper stretch, bid outside horses inside the eighth pole and narrowly prevailed. BAD NEWS CAPTAIN , well back early, steadied near the five sixteenths pole, hugged the inner rail, raced on his left lead, bid for the lead near the sixteenth pole then hung. BAKU , two deep on the turn, angled to the five path while between horses in midstretch and passed tired rivals. SCOFIELD , five deep leaving the turn, passed tired horses. BELLAMY FLEET chased the pace three deep on the turn and faded the final furlong. AMERICAN CAT chased the pace two wide on the turn and weakened in the drive. ALWORTH saved ground on the turn while setting the pace, drifted out in upper stretch and weakened. DENVER DUEL circled the turn four deep, chased the pace and gave way. ZAJAL , rank leaving the starting gate, was five deep on the turn and faltered.
