Footnotes

AMPHORAE was taken to rate along the inside, moved up along the rail into the lane, swung four wide, closed determinedly and wore down I HEAR THAT in an extended drive. I HEAR THAT dueled along the inside, went clear in mid stretch, drifted out late and battled gamely. TRUE BLUE GIRL was taken to rate, moved up between rivals around the final turn, angled four wide for the drive and lacked a solid response. AGELIKA lacked a solid response. THEATRICAL AFFAIR lacked speed, made a steady wide run leaving the three furlong marker then flattened out through the lane. BRONZE BALLERINA dueled two wide to upper stretch and weakened. SEW SANGUE SLEW lacked speed, entered the lane four wide and swerved in leaving the eighth pole. ALL TOO OFTEN was used four wide around the first turn, rated back a bit in early backstretch, stalked the pace for a half mile and faltered. DANCING CHEVRON was used five wide to get a short lead into the backstretch, prompted the pace three wide to the five sixteenths marker then tired. PRIVATE PROM PARTY was rated back between rivals to stalk the pace, raced towards the inside, tired in upper stretch and was steadied leaving the eighth pole.
